The Coopers arrived as AIMers in Mairinque, São Paulo, Brazil in 2012. They opened a Bible school in 2013. They have trained more than ten local pastors that have been sent all over Brazil. They also built their first orphanage house and it is up and running. They help endangered women and families and the local government uses them for this purpose. The Coopers hold children's crusades throughout Brazil and have seen more than 6,000 receive the Holy Ghost. They pastor a church in São Paulo and have built three churches and opened two daughter works. Upon returning to the field, they plan to begin new works in the twenty-six surrounding cities and build a house for training AIMers and Brazilian nationals. They plan to expand the orphanage and build a private school on the property.
