The Grays started their missions journey as furlough replacements in Botswana for five weeks in 2018. Later, they served for thirteen months under the AIM program. Bradley worked with a national minister doing Bible studies, counseling, visitor follow-ups, new converts classes, and community center ministry. They went back to Botswana as Associate Missionaries to establish a church in a new city. In less than a year, they baptized over forty people and twenty received the Holy Ghost. Four nationalities were represented in their diverse congregation. As intermediate missionaries, they are going to Zambia to assist in the Bible school and Children's Ministries. They will develop strategies to establish churches in smaller villages and rural areas with the aim of reaching the unreached people groups in the country.
