



The Smoaks are missionaries who began their work in Kenya in 1986. They were appointed to Tanzania in 1988 and have been actively involved in evangelism, church planting, developing leaders, and providing Bible school instruction. Brother Smoak is an advisor to the national boards of Tanzania and Burundi, and was appointed as the Area Coordinator for the seventeen nations of East Africa in 2016. Sister Smoak coordinates the translation of materials into Swahili. Returning to the field, the Smoaks will continue advising and encouraging the leadership of both countries and the long-term advancement of all the Bible schools, as well as continuing literature translation.
