Lynden Shalm was raised with his two brothers in India by his missionary parents George and Margaret Shalm. After his Bible school training, Lynden pastored in Belleville and Beaverton, Ontario, and served as the Ontario District youth secretary for five years. He was the principal of United Pentecostal Bible Institute in Fredericton, New Brunswick, when he and his wife were appointed as missionaries to Sri Lanka and Pakistan in May 1984. In Pakistan he served as the general secretary of the UPC of Pakistan, principal of New Life Training Center in Lahore and supervisor for the Central District. He worked very closely with the national leadership to help them fulfill their goals of evangelism and training. He also conducted leadership and youth training seminars and preached crusades and evangelistic outreaches. In October 2002, the General Board of the UPCI appointed Lynden as the regional director for the Asia Region. As the director he oversees the entire Asian region and seeks to open new areas to the gospel.
