Testimony of God's hand of protection during a recent medical emergency for Bro. David Kline:

We traveled to East Lansing, Michigan, on the Saturday after the General Conference. On 25 Sept'23 Monday morning, we were about to travel 500 miles to the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. I felt something was very wrong, like someone was sitting on my chest. So I called a friend & Pastor M. K. Sartin, he prayed with me. The shortness of breath did not stop. We requested the hotel to call for an ambulance. The paramedics took me by ambulance to the emergency room where they confirmed it was a heart attack. The proper medical terminology was ST-elevation myocardial infarction involving the left circumflex coronary artery (HCC). They took me into surgery and performed two Angioplasty (balloons) and inserted one stint. The heart surgery went well, and I have not had any additional problems or major complications since. **Praise the Lord, Glory to God, Hallelujah, Thank you Jesus!**

After three days, I was released from hospital and they felt I was stable enough to slowly (*at least a three-day journey*) make our way back to New Orleans, LA. My sister and brother-in-law drove us down to New Orleans (*a tremendous blessing*) for additional follow-up and medical treatments.

On Monday, October 2, I saw the cardiologist in New Orleans, LA, who told us the prognosis looked good, and he thinks I am out of imminent danger. He ordered several tests and referred me to a cardiac surgeon, to discuss if open heart surgery is necessary. All the tests were favorable, with **No need for bypass surgery at this time! Praise the Lord!**

We are so grateful for all the support and love for us during this time of medical emergency. We are very thankful for all the support from Bro. & Sis. Schwarz, Bro. Abernathy, and all the Global Missions staff. Thank you for all card's, messages, and love offerings. Please keep the prayers coming our way, and God Bless all of you!
