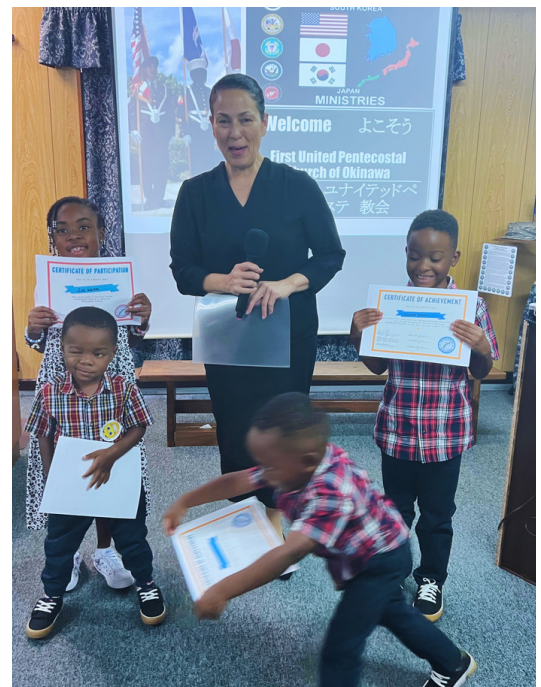


BACK TO SCHOOL PRAYER 2023!

FUPC 43RD ANNIVERSARY

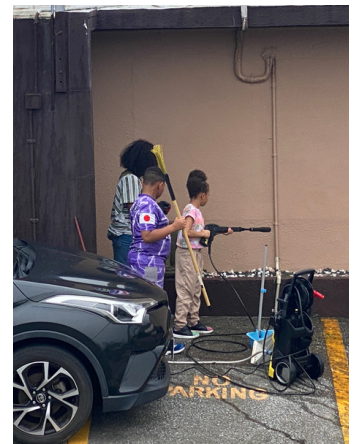
He's Been Faithful!
