# WILLIAM AND ELIZABETH TURNER MEMORIAL BUILDING TALLIN, ESTONIA

The first church property to be owned by the UPC in Tallinn, Estonia is to be. memorial building dedicated to God in honor of William and Elizabeth Turner, who served as UPCI missionaries for 36 years from 1978 through the end of 2014 in South Korea, Russia and the former Soviet Union until their retirement, helping launch UPCI efforts into all of them. For more than a decade they organized area training, leadership and youth conferences and pastored the church in Moscow, Russia. over the years their area travel took them across 11 time zones from Kaliningrad, Russia on the Baltic Sea in the west to the city of Magadan, Russia, farther east than Tokyo. In recognition, of the many people in many nations who have been saved and blessed through their ministry, the headquarters church for the nation of Estonia will be named in their honor. **Cost: \$1,000,000.**PROJECT #: GMMFB.43696.2110
