

After feeling the call to missions, Joshua and Lalaina Tingley served in Barcelona for three years on both Associates in Missions and Associate Missionary programs. During that time they helped the nation of Spain navigate COVID, advanced technologies and sound, facilitated the construction of a new church building, preached across the country, aided in the launching of new churches, conducted prayer walks, served as financial secretary for three area churches, and taught multiple seminars. Additionally, the Tingleys served as furlough pastors in the nation of Andorra, during which time they saw many receive the Acts 2:38 message. The Tingleys are now Intermediate Missionaries to the countries of Haiti and the Dominican Republic, where they are involved in the national work, training, Bible school, and humanitarian aid. They will be running the first missionary training center in the CAC, the Missionary Gateway Center, in the Dominican Republic. Their focus is to train and equip new missionaries for work in the CAC region and beyond.
