



The Wicketts were appointed as missionaries to Fiji and the Solomon Islands in 2016. Upon their arrival in Fiji in 2018, they assumed responsibility for the administration of the Bible school with thirty students. Over the next three years, they opened three new Bible school campuses and had a record enrollment of 135 students at their four campuses. Their focus is on teaching and training the locals, traveling to local churches, and evangelizing throughout Fiji. They plan to open two more campuses upon their return. Troy Wickett, as Assistant General Superintendent of the work in the Solomon Islands and President of the Bible college, has traveled to the Solomon Islands conducting teaching seminars to help support the work and ministry as they continue to see greater revival. He is also the GATS (Global Association of Theological Studies) Pacific Representative and has traveled to various countries in the Pacific Region assisting Bible and conducting faculty development schools training.
